

TOWN WARRANT
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

TO THE INHABITANTS OF THE TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER IN THE COUNTY OF GRAFTON IN SAID STATE, QUALIFIED TO VOTE IN TOWN AFFAIRS:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Bridgewater on Tuesday, the Eleventh day of March, 2014 next at twelve of the clock in the noon to act on the following subjects:

Polls to be opened from 12 Noon to 6:00 p.m.

Business Meeting 7:30 pm

1. To choose a Selectman for three (3) years and all other necessary town officials.
2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$ 1,384,818.00 which represents the operational budget. **Said sum does not include amounts in separate or special warrant articles.** (Majority vote required.) Recommended by the Selectmen.
3. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$90,000 for capital improvements to replace the town hall and highway building roofs; the purchase of a highway sander and snow plow; paint two buildings; supplemental road surfacing; and ambulance upgrades and further, to authorize the transfer of \$90,000 from the December 31st 2013 fund balance. (Majority vote required.) Recommended by the Selectmen
4. To see if the town will vote to accept the provisions of RSA 289:6 II-a providing that the Selectmen serve for the term of elected office as the cemetery trustees indefinitely until specific recession of such authority by subsequent Town Meeting by voting the following " Shall we delegate the duties and responsibilities of the cemetery trustees to the Board of Selectmen?" Recommended by the Selectmen
5. To see if the voters of the Towns of Hebron and Bridgewater will direct the School Board of the Newfound Area School District to undertake a study of the feasibility and suitability of the withdrawal of the Towns of Hebron and Bridgewater from the cooperative district. In accordance with RSA 195, Section 25, the study shall be conducted by a committee composed of at least one member of the School Board from each of the pre-existing districts, one member of the Board of Selectmen from each town, and such other members as may be appointed by the committee. Within 180 days after the date of formation, the committee shall report its findings to the State Board of Education. There is no cost for this study. Recommended by The Selectmen of Hebron and Bridgewater.
6. To see if the town will vote to call upon the US Congress with the support of the NH State Legislature, to move forward with a Constitutional Amendment to regulate political spending and clarify that constitutional rights were established for people and not corporations and, if such an amendment be approved, that the NH State Legislature support such and amendment if sent to the State for ratification. By Petition.
7. To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.
